

### PENTHOUSE SUITE

MANDARIN ORIENTAL BARCELONA, BARCELONA, SPAIN

Just steps away from Plaça de Catalunya, La Pedrera and Antoni Gaudí's Casa Batlló, Mandarin Oriental Barcelona houses one of the city's most glamorous penthouses. The space, occupying the hotel's entire eighth floor, features sophisticated and contemporary decor with a soothing color palette, floor-to-ceiling windows and two terraces with scenic vistas of the Barcelona cityscape. The terrace is best enjoyed with an alfresco dinner as you watch the sun set over the Passeig de Gràcia.

# PALLADIO SUITE

BELMOND HOTEL CIPRIANI, VENICE, ITALY

Just a five-minute boat ride from St Mark's Square, Belmond Hotel Cipriani on Giudecca Island captures the traditional spirit of Venice through its opulent 18th-century decor, oil paintings and proximity to the lagoon. The Palladio Suite is flooded by natural light thanks to its marvelous floor-to-ceiling windows with 180-degree views of the Venetian Lagoon and Venice itself. The suite, including the bathroom, is laden with Italian marble, Murano-glass lamps and chandeliers, and draped with Rubelli curtains. If you seek privacy from the openness of the suite (which is suspended over the lagoon) head to the heated plunge pool on the manicured terrace. Its fragrant jasmine bushes shield you from those sailing on the water, so you can enjoy your Venetian retreat in peace.

# VILLA SIMILAN, LAYAN RESIDENCES

ANANTARA LAYAN PHUKET RESORT, PHUKET, THAILAND

Villa Similan at Layan Bay in Phuket overlooks the sparkling Andaman Sea. Nestled into the surrounding greenery, this exclusive eight-bedroom residence sits at the highest point permitted for residential construction in the area, and was designed by the late Indonesian design guru, Jaya Ibrahim. Enjoy views of the jungle and sea from the expansive terrace, or from the 72-ft cliffside infinity pool. In its Kohinoor Suite (named for the famous 105.6-carat Indian diamond that is now part of the British Crown Jewels), white marble columns, white elephants, domed ceilings and views of Taj Mahal from every room set the exotic scene. It has an expansive terrace that spans the length of the suite, with sun loungers for day and an elegant table for dining at night. There are few evenings more romantic than dinner overlooking the shrine that symbolizes eternal love.
